With several countries reporting that COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) is spreading within the general population, Timiskaming Health Unit continues to be involved in planning and preparedness activities with local partners and provincial counterparts from the Ministry of Health and Public Health Ontario.

Our top priority is the health and safety of individuals in our district. Currently there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the district of Temiskaming and the risk of spread within our district continues to remain low at this time. The public health risk is continually being reassessed as new information becomes available.
