- Participate in knowledge exchange, monitoring, evaluation and reporting.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Baccalaureate in nutrition or equivalent program from a recognized university; Masters degree in nutrition, public health or related is considered an asset;
- Experience working in public health or in community nutrition is considered an asset;
- Proof of registration or eligibility for membership with the College of Dietitians of Ontario;
- Experience in population health assessment, interpreting and synthesizing research and technical information;
- Experience in program planning and evidence-informed decision making;
- Demonstrated skills in project management and in implementing and evaluating population health promotion interventions including social marketing, and healthy public policy;
- Strong interpersonal, communication, problem solving, facilitation and organizational skills;
- Experience in developing and supporting collaborative relationships with partners;
