JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assignments will vary but will mainly support our Infectious Diseases, IPAC and VPD programs:

- Provide leadership and expertise related to the surveillance, prevention and control of infections, immunizations, and vaccine management;
- Lead the planning, development, implementation, coordination and evaluation of improvements in infection prevention and control, vaccine and immunization related activities;
- Act as a liaison and resource with our external partners and other settings in the prevention of infections, vaccine and immunization;
- Work collaboratively on multidisciplinary teams, providing assessment, advice and consultation to individuals, communities and community partners;
- Work collaboratively with internal partners to plan, develop, implement and evaluate health promotion and prevention programs.
