THU SEARCH OF RECORD AND RESPONSE:

- Based on the above information received, we were unable to locate a record for this sewage system in our files. It is suggested that the purchaser have the septic tank pumped. An examination of the inlet and outlet baffles and the depth of the scum and sludge will assist in determining the maintenance of the system over the past years.
Note: life expectancy of a sewage system is dependent on past usage and maintenance.
- Our records indicate a final inspection report was **not** issued. Copy of Certificate of Approval attached.
- A search of our records indicates there are no outstanding work orders against this sewage system at this time.
- A final inspection report/application for a permit to construct was issued. Please find copies of these documents attached.
- Our Unit has not conducted an exhaustive examination of this property and neighbouring land and this response is subject to a ny matters an examination of the site and neighbouring lands might reveal.
- File search reveals that this system consists of a steel tank and according to the Ontario Building Code, all steel tanks must be replaced.
