## Format Changes:

Two versions

- Printable booklet on 8.5x11 paper (16 pages)
- Larger-print, assembled schedules that can be posted and/or kept with the full schedules for easy reference in immunization areas (printed on 8.5x11 paper and assembled)

## Updates:

- Vaccine updates including: HPV-9, Rotavirus-5, Herpes Zoster (Shingrix). Removed references to Td-IPV, DTaP-IPV, and DTaP-IPV-Hib (where applicable)
- Updated wording to provide clarity and updated catch-up tables to accommodate 'aging-out' of applicable cohorts

## **COVID-19 Vaccines**

In Ontario, health professionals are required to report Adverse Event Following Immunization (AEFI) to their local public health unit. Public health units investigate AEFIs and provide support to immunizers, individuals, and their families.
