This bulletin will also provide an opportunity to summarize some of the work THU has done in preparation for vaccine coming to our district. Note, no specific date for this arrival is known at this time. Highlights include:

- A -20 C freezer has been acquired and installed at THU.
- A vaccination playbook is presently being constructed. This will be finalized and submitted to General Hillier and the Ministry before the January 22 deadline.
- Medical directives for vaccination have been developed and are being finalized.
- Storage and handling procedures for COVID vaccine have been developed and are being finalized.
- A consent form has been developed and is being finalized.
- Training is up-coming for COVAX, the provincial IT tool that has been developed for the COVID vaccine.
- A prioritization list for Wave 1 has been developed by the province and will be applied locally once we know the number of vaccines and timeline for THU.
