Delayed Local Reactions Due to COVID-19 Vaccinations with Moderna

Some patients may experience a delayed localized injection site reaction, ~8 days post-vaccination. Reactions including erythema, induration, and tenderness will typically resolve within 4 to 5 days without the use of antibiotics. They are not characterized by systemic symptoms and do not increase the risk of anaphylaxis with future vaccination. The mechanism could be T-cell mediated similar to Tuberculin response.

The reactions have been reported to occur after vaccinating with the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. If an individual has experienced a delayed local reaction in the past, they may still receive vaccines in the future. There is a **decreased** frequency of delayed local reactions following the second dose of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

When providing the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, include counselling to patients about delayed local reactions and reassure all individuals that the reaction is benign and self-limited.

Delayed local reactions should be reported as an Adverse Event Following Immunization if they last greater than 4 days or extend beyond the nearest joint whether it is delayed or immediate as per the <u>provincial case definition</u>.
